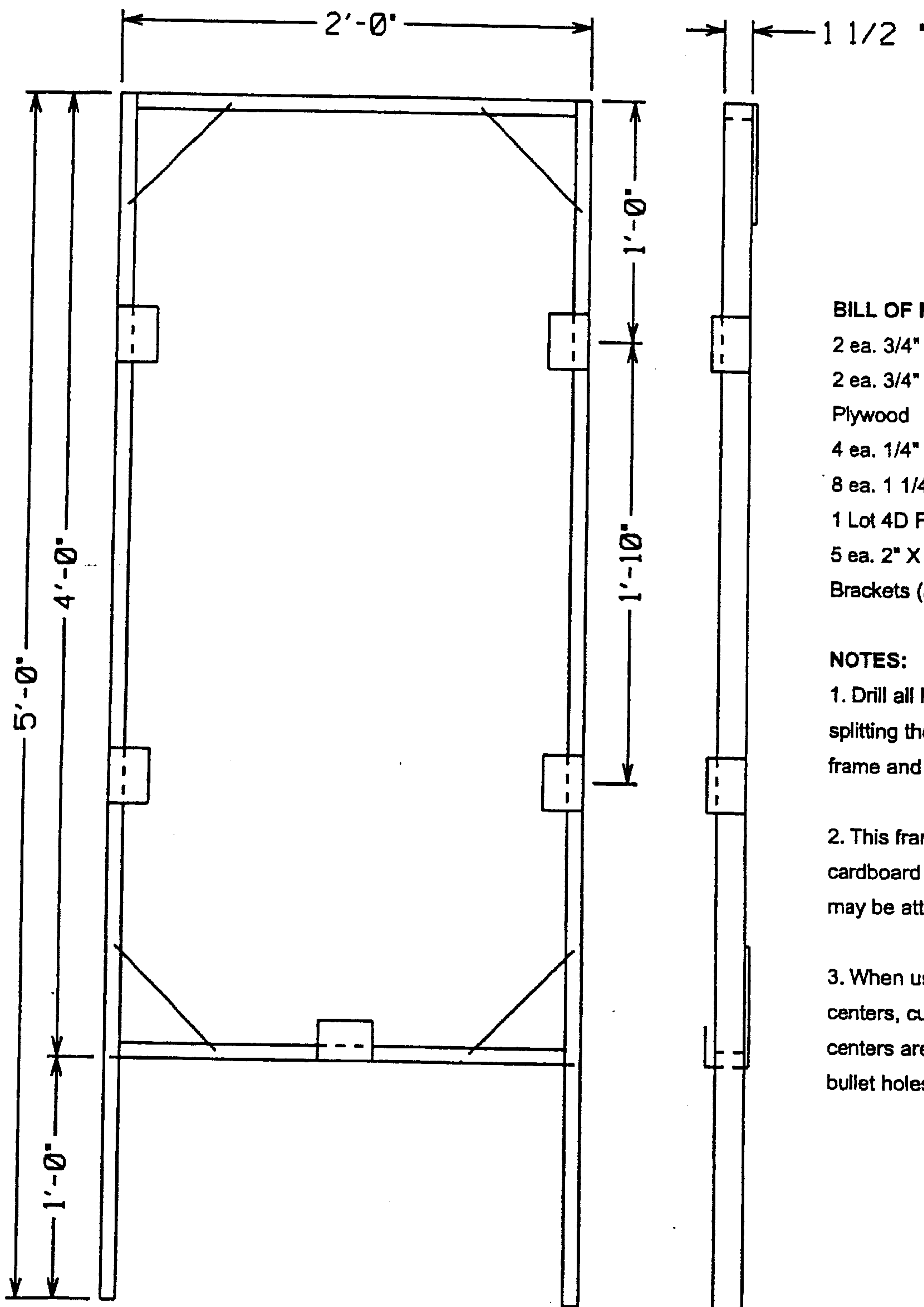


CMRPC 100 & 200 Yard Rifle Target Holder Frame



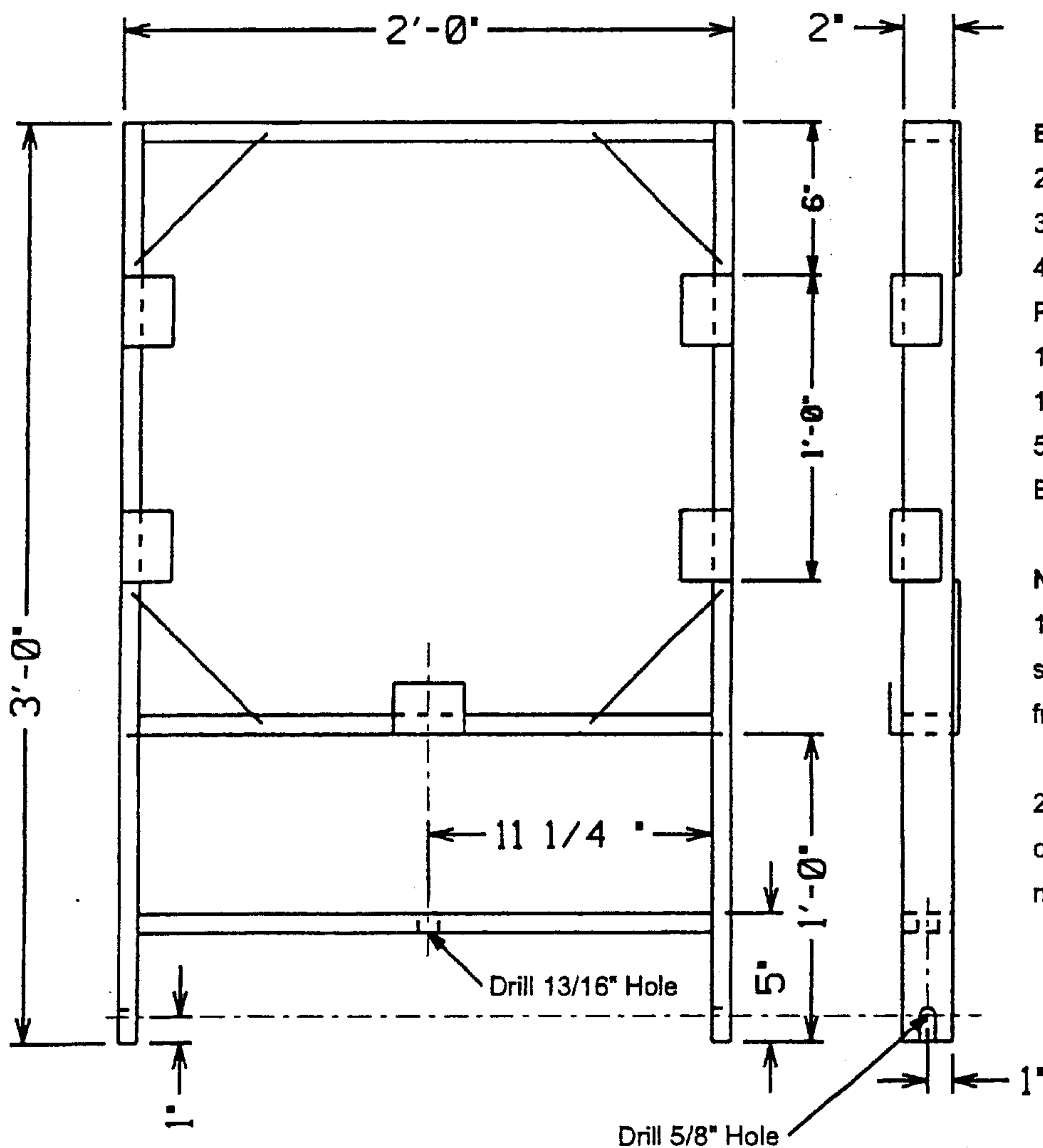
BILL OF MATERIALS:

- 2 ea. 3/4" X 1 1/2" X 60" Exterior Grade Plywood
- 2 ea. 3/4" X 1 1/2" X 22 1/2" Exterior Grade Plywood
- 4 ea. 1/4" X 6" X 6" Exterior Grade Plywood
- 8 ea. 1 1/4" coarse Thread Dry Wall Screws
- 1 Lot 4D Finishind Nails
- 5 ea. 2" X 2" X 2 1/2" Plastic Banding Corner Brackets (available from club)

NOTES:

1. Drill all holes for nails and screws to avoid splitting the wood. Use nails to assemble the frame and dry wall screws to attach the gussets
2. This frame is designed to use 24" X 48" cardboard or hardboard inserts to witch targets may be attached
3. When using bulls-eye targets with black centers, cutting out the cardboard, where the centers are, facilitates seeing small caliber bullet holes with a spotting or rifle scope.

CMRPC 25 & 50 Yard Pistol Target Holder Frame



BILL OF MATERIALS:

- 2 ea. 3/4" X 2" X 36" Exterior Grade Plywood
- 3 ea. 3/4" X 2" X 22 1/2" Exterior Grade Plywood
- 4 ea. Gussets 1/4" X 6" X 6" Exterior Grade Plywood
- 15 ea. 3/4" Coarse Thread Dry Wall Screws
- 1 Lot 4D Finishing Nails
- 5 ea. 2" X 2" X 2 1/2" Plastic Banding Corner Brackets (available from club)

NOTES:

1. Drill all holes for nails and screws to avoid splitting the wood. Use nails to assemble the frame and dry wall screws to attach the gussets.
2. This frame is designed to use 24" X 24" cardboard or hardboard inserts to which targets may be attached.
